James Clarke and Co Ltd was founded in 1859 in Fleet Street, London. It produced the highly influential religious magazine, *Christian World*, which by the outbreak of the First World War was selling over 100,000 copies a week, and was the leading nonconformist weekly.

In addition James Clarke and Co began to publish books, at first these were mainly imports from the United States – very unusual at a time when American publishing relied heavily on buying from Britain. Major American preachers and theologians, such as Henry Ward Beecher, were thus introduced to British readers.

More recently the Company has specialised in academic and reference works. Major texts such as the *New Testament Apocrypha* edited by Schneemelcher, and the *Encyclopedia of the Early Church* edited by Angelo di Berardino have established themselves as the authoritative texts. Outside the religious field the main reference work is the biennial *The Libraries Directory*, providing detailed information on British and Irish libraries.
