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URBAN CLAESSION is Doctor in Church History and Researcher at the Church of Sweden Research Unit. His main areas of research are the emergence of Pietism in Sweden during the seventeenth century and the nation building processes during the nineteenth and the twentieth centuries in relation to the Nordic Folk Churches. He has published *Folkhemmets kyrka. Harald Hallén och folkkyrkans genombrott* (A Church for a Social Democratic Nation. Harald Hallén and the emergence of the Swedish Folk Church, 2004). He has also published articles on the Nordic Folk Churches and on early Swedish Pietism.

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NIELS HENRIK GREGERSEN is Professor of Systematic Theology at the Faculty of Theology, Copenhagen University, Denmark. His main research areas are contemporary Protestant theology, and the relations between theology and the biological sciences. His publications include *The Gift of Grace: The Future of Lutheran Theology* (2005), *Information and the Nature of Reality* (2010), *Lutherbilleder i dansk teologi 1800–2000* (Luther in Danish Theology 1800–2000, 2012), and *Den bevægelige Ortodoksi: Konflikt og kontinuitet i kristendommen* (Orthodoxy in Transition: Conflict and Continuity in the Christian tradition, 2014).

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
